Since it began, over 500 students have submitted over 1000 photos to the competition.

The winning photos appear in a calendar, on our website and in Rangelands NRM publications. Additionally they also go up for exhibition at the WA Museum Boola Bardip.

For 2023 we are also inviting video applications of up to 30 seconds.

The theme for 2023 is "Natural Surprises, Hidden Beauty"

CONDITIONS:

- An entry form (with permission to use photo) must be filled in for each child entering the competition and signed by parents/guardians.
- Photos must be taken by the child who is entering the competition.
- Maximum of four (4) photo entries per child.
- Images to be submitted either via [TransferBigFiles.com](https://www.transferbigfiles.com) (just add files - no need to sign up) or by email to info@rangelandswa.com.au.
- Images must be 2MB or larger - the winning entries will be used in the 2024 Calendar and printed for exhibition at the WA Museum Boola Bardip and thus need to be high resolution. Entries will also be featured through Rangelands NRM publications including social media.
- Video entries can be up to 30 seconds in duration. They can be shorter, but not go over 30 seconds.
- Winning video entries will not be featured in the 2024 calendar, but will be featured on various social media channels.
- Children will be acknowledged on calendar and in exhibition by first name only alongside school and year group.
